House Rules

Hello,

First of all, welcome to our farm!

We would like to give you some information and rules to ensure you have a pleasant stay on the farm.

- -We sort our **waste** as carefully as possible. Each bin has a label showing what can go in it, please follow this as closely as you can. If your trash bag is full, please leave it by the second door of the yellow barn building. New bags can be found in the cupboard under the stairs.
- -If you have a little **accident** and something breaks, or something is already broken, please let us know so we can fix it for the next guests. (You break it, you pay for it).
- -Important rule for **smokers**: Please do not smoke inside the house or other buildings. Also, don't smoke near the horses. Be very careful around the hay barn due to fire risk. Don't leave cigarette butts on the property. There's a pot by the house door where you can dispose of them.
- -We have a quiet hours rule from **10 p.m**. Please keep noise to a minimum after that time.
- -You are **responsible** for your own safety on our property.

The emergency number in Poland is **112**.

- -We have a small **BBQ** available. You need to bring your own charcoal. If you'd like to make a **campfire**, there's a designated spot between the paddocks. Feel free to use it, just make sure it's safe.
- -If you bring **pets**, you're fully responsible for them. Dogs are not allowed near the horses to prevent accidents and maintain calm. Also, respect wildlife, especially in spring when there are many animals with young, don't let your dog roam off-leash during walks.
- -Feel free to say hello to the **horses**, but please do not feed them. Be careful around the fences, they are electric. If you want to interact with the horses, just let us know first. They are big animals, and accidents can happen quickly.

- -You're welcome to use the **wood stove**. The ash tray can be emptied into the large pot by the door outside. If you have any questions about the stove, just ask.
- -Please don't feed or let in the **cats**. All the cats you see already have a home.
- -Our **chickens** love food scraps. Non-edible green waste can go into the wooden bin next to the vegetable garden and chicken coop. Sometimes, you can buy fresh eggs, we ask 1 PLN per egg.
- -Please check out by **10:00 a.m.**, so we have enough time to clean the house for the next guests. Please return furniture to its original place, put clean dishes back in the cupboards, and empty the fridge.

We hope you have a wonderful stay at our farm.
