

Farm House Rules

Hello,

First of all, welcome to our farm!

We would like to share some information and rules so you can enjoy a pleasant stay on the farm.

For the campsite:

-Wi-Fi:

-There's no facility for emptying **chemical toilets**.

-Please keep the door of the **sanitary building** closed as much as possible to keep insects out, and don't leave the lights on unnecessarily.

-Be mindful of **water** usage.

-Keep the **sanitary facilities** clean, it's more pleasant for you and for the next guest.

-We sort our **waste** carefully. Each bin has a label indicating what goes in it. Please follow this as best you can.

-The **chickens** love food scraps. Sometimes it's possible to buy fresh eggs. We ask 1 PLN per egg.

-**Green waste** can go in the wooden bin next to the vegetable garden and chicken coop.

-Please don't feed or let in the **cats** (some daredevils might sneak into your tent or camper!). All the cats you see already have a home.

-If there's an **accident** and something gets damaged, or something is already broken, please let us know so we can fix it for the next guests. (You break it, you pay for it)

-Important rule for smokers: **no smoking** inside the buildings, and please also don't smoke near the horses. Be especially careful around the hay barn due to fire risk.

-We have a **10 p.m.** quiet time rule. After that, please keep things calm.

-You are **responsible** for your own safety on our property.
The emergency number in Poland is **112**.

-You can make a **campfire** in the area between the paddocks. You may use the wood that is there. The grill may also be used. If you want to make a

larger fire, you can easily remove the grill by detaching the chain, the legs will stay in place.

-If you brought your own **BBQ**, feel free to use it as long as it's high enough not to touch the grass.

-**Payment** is made the day before departure. You can pay in euros or Polish zloty. A new day starts at **4:00 p.m.**

-If you bring **pets**, you are responsible for them. Dogs must be on a leash and must not be near the horses to avoid accidents and keep the peace. Also, be mindful of wildlife. Especially in spring, there are many animals with young, please do not let your dog off-leash during walks out of respect for wild animals.

-You are welcome to say hello to the **horses**, but please **do not feed them**. Watch out for the electric fencing.
If you'd like to interact with the horses, please let us know. They are large animals, and accidents can happen quickly.

We wish you a very pleasant stay on our farm.
